Sub : Admission Guidelines 2010

The Academic Advisory Committee(ACC) of KVS, in its 34th meeting held on 26.11.2009 had proposed certain amendments related to Admission Guidelines 2009 and the Board of Governors(BOG) of KVS has ratified the decision in its 85th meeting held on 14.12.2009. The following Amendment be inserted in para 8(A) of Admission Guidelines 2009.

The Admission Guidelines 2010 will become effective w.e.f the academic session 2010-11. Article 8(A) of Admission Guidelines, regarding class strength and upper ceiling may be modified as given below to admit more number of children by 31st July during normal admission period without changing the upper ceiling pertaining to class strength.

Note: Under col.4 three students could be admitted in each section under Special Provisions(other than those chosen by the sponsoring authority), which included Special Dispensation also. If vacancy exists ever after 30th September, Commissioner, KVS is empowered to grant admission to the wards of Cat.I employees who are actually coming on transfer after 30th September and before 30th November . However, the upper ceiling as mentioned in Col.6 will be strictly enforced in Class I to begin with. In all

other classes, the vacancies caused on account of transfers shall not be filled up except KV to KV transfers warranted on account of the actual transfer of parent(s).
